### **Concept Note of National Conference**

International Humanitarian Law (IHL) is a set of rules which seek, for humanitarian reasons, to limit the effects of armed conflict. It protects persons who are not, or no longer, directly participating in the hostilities. IHL also restricts the means and methods of warfare. The Conference will address specific topics, such as recent trends in the classification of armed conflicts, foreign fighters, counter terrorism and IHL, challenges in the conduct of hostilities in today's armed conflicts, sexual violence and detention-related issues, implementation of IHL in courts and also IHL teaching and research methodology. The 3rd edition of this Advanced Conference aims at providing humanitarian professionals with relevant background knowledge in International Humanitarian Law (IHL). The programme is designed to encourage discussions and debates on the main IHL issues arising in today's armed conflicts. The Conference will also enhance the capacity of lecturers and researchers to teach and research IHL contemporary issues, addressing both substantive and pedagogical aspects.

9. Technology Asymmetry and the Law of Armed Conflicts.
10. New Technology of Warfare: Cyber Warfare, Autonomous Weapon System.

Quality Research Papers, including Field Studies, from Scholars, Researchers, Bar & Bench, Teachers, NGOs/ Civil Societies and Students are invited based on the topics mentioned in the Conference theme. The list in the sub themes is not exhaustive. Any other contemporary themes related to the main theme are admissible. The papers should be original and unpublished. One or more authors may be included in the paper. The paper must be presented either by the author or co-author.

All papers are subject to scrutiny by an expert committee and only selected papers are permitted for presentation in the Conference. Please bring hard and soft copies of the full paper on the day of the Conference. Soft copy of Power Point Presentation should be in CD or in Pen Drives.

**Only those papers which are accepted by the Editorial Committee will be included in the Conference Proceedings.**

### **Submission Guidelines**

Kindly send a soft copy in MS Word format and hard copy (Font: "Times New Roman"/ Size 12 and 1.5 line spacing with normal print margin) of the abstract and full paper not exceeding 8 pages including statistical data, figures and other annexure as per the schedule given below. At the end of the paper, there should be a brief profile of the author with E-mail ID, contact number and address. Articles received after the stipulated deadline will not be entertained for presentation in the Conference. Selected papers will be published as a book with ISBN number. Certificate for actual participation shall be issued after completion of your presentation.
