Do's	Don'ts
View with suspicion unsolicited emails or pages asking for personal information. (Particularly those claiming to be from banks and credit card companies).	Give away more information than necessary. Your bank and credit card provider already knows your pin number and address.
Update your software / apps regularly. Most updates fix existing security vulnerabilities misused by malwares.	Give the OTP received on your mobile to any caller, even if he or she claims to be a bank or government official.
Use Anti-Virus Software to keep your computer free of common malware.	Click on attachments and links without knowing their true origin.
Always keep your WI-FI networks protected & choose your password carefully.	Access online banking from shared or public computers to protect your personal data.
