1. Eligibility Criteria

a) UG (Integrated LLB)

• Educational Qualification:

Must have passed Class 12 (10+2) or equivalent from a recognized board. Final-year students appearing in 2026 are also eligible, provided they submit passing proof during admission.

- Minimum Marks Required:
 - o General / OBC / PWD / NRI / PIO / OCI: ≥ 45% aggregate.
 - \circ SC / ST: ≥ 40% aggregate.
- Age Limit: No upper age limit.

b) PG (LL.M)

• Educational Qualification:

Must hold a 3-year or 5-year LLB (or equivalent) from a recognized university. Final-year students awaiting results may also apply, given they furnish proof of graduation at admission.

- Minimum Marks Required:
 - o General / OBC / PWD / NRI / PIO / OCI: ≥ 50% in LLB.
 - o SC / ST: ≥ 45%.
- Age Limit: No upper age limit.

2. Exam Pattern (UG & PG)

a) Common Features

- Mode: Offline, pen-and-paper based.
- **Duration**: 2 hours (120 minutes).
- Question Type: Objective Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs), passage/passage-based.
- Total Questions: 120.
- Marks: Each correct answer gives +1 mark; wrong answers attract –0.25 marks; no penalty for unattempted questions.
- Exam Date: Scheduled for Sunday, December 7, 2025, 2 PM 4 PM.

• Sections & Weightage:

Section	Questions	Approx. Weightage
English Language	22–26	~20%
Current Affairs + General Knowledge	28–32	~25%
Legal Reasoning	28–32	~25%
Logical Reasoning	22–26	~20%
Quantitative Techniques	10–14	~10%

c) PG Pattern

- **Structure**: 120 objective MCQs covering:
 - Constitutional Law (roughly 60 questions)
 - Other areas: Contracts, Torts, Criminal Law, Property Law, Jurisprudence, Administrative Law, Family Law, Company Law, International Law, Tax Law, Environmental Law, Labour & Industrial Law.
- Scoring and Marking: Same as UG (+1/-0.25).

3. Syllabus Overview

a) UG Syllabus Breakdown

1. English Language

- Reading comprehension passages (~450–500 words)
- Topics: Main idea, inference, tone, vocabulary-in-context, summary/paraphrase
- Grammar and vocabulary: Synonyms, antonyms, sentence correction, rearrangement, cloze tests.

2. Current Affairs & General Knowledge

- Contemporary national and international events
- Government schemes, awards, sports, S&T developments
- Static GK: Indian history, polity, geography, economics basics.

3. Legal Reasoning

- Factual scenarios requiring application of legal principles
- Topics: Law of Contracts, Torts, Criminal Law, Constitutional Law
- Includes recent judgments, legal maxims, amendments.

4. Logical Reasoning

- Critical reasoning: arguments, inference, assumption, strengthen/weaken
- Analytical sections: Arrangements, puzzles, syllogisms, coding-decoding, blood relations
- Sequences and analogies.

5. Quantitative Techniques

- Arithmetic: Percentages, profit/loss, interest, time-speed-distance, ratios, averages, number systems
- Data interpretation: Graphs, tables, charts, data sufficiency.

b) PG Syllabus Areas

- Based on extract-based comprehension
- Key legal domains tested: Constitutional Law, Jurisprudence, Administrative Law, Contracts, Torts, Criminal Law, Property Law, Family Law, Company Law, International Law, Tax Law, Environmental Law, Labour & Industrial Law.
