INTELLECTUAL DOMAIN

Guest Lecture on "Role of Mediation in Family Disputes" by Mr. R. S. Goswami, Senior Advocate & Chairman of Enrollment Committee, Bar Council of Delhi

The CPJ College of Higher Studies & School of Law, Narela (Affiliated to GGSIPU, Delhi) successfully organized a Guest Lecture on "Role of Mediation in Family Disputes" on **6-February-2019**. The Programme began with the National Anthem and Lighting of Auspicious lamp as a tribute to Goddess Sarawati. After this, a warm welcome was extended to the Chief Guest Mr. R. S. Goswami Senior Advocate & Chairman, Enrollment Committee, Bar Council of Delhi and he was felicitated with a Tulsi plant and memento by Mr. Yugank Chaturvedi, Director General-CPJ.

The theme of the guest lecture was on the concept of Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR). The term ADR is used to describe several different modes of resolving legal disputes. The main purpose of this guest lecture was to highlight the fact that mediation process is beneficial for both the sides - the courts are being a bit less burdened with cases and the parties are getting their issues resolved quickly with less hassles and in a smoother way. Law students understand about the mediation in Indian Law and its significance.

Firstly, Mr. Yugank Chaturvedi, Director General, -CPJ, in his welcoming address spoke about the varied experience of Mr. R.S. Goswami. While addressing the students he stated that as Law students, they need to understand about the resolution of disputes through mediation which has been experienced by the business world as well as common men as it is impracticable for many individuals to file law suits and get timely justice. It is a known fact that the Courts are backlogged with dockets resulting in delay of year or more for the parties to have their cases heard and decided. To solve this problem of delayed justice, ADR Mechanism has been developed. It can be said that ADR is an indispensable process for making social life peaceful. Dispute resolution process through mediation is easy and it tries to resolve disputes amicably. It checks conflicts between individuals and enables persons and groups to maintain co-operation.

The Chief Guest Mr. R.S. Goswami started his lecture with a very positive note that CPJ College students have impressed

him in several ways, be it professional ethics, sincerity and knowledge of the subject or having developed good communication skills and hardworking habits. He also praised the Director General and the Management of the college for maintaining excellent learning environment and providing best facilities to the students through rich stocked library, well equipped computer lab and other requisite infrastructural facilities etc. His inspiring words about the dignity and importance of legal profession in the society, government and politics motivated the students and attracted their huge applause.

He enlightened the students that a Judicial Settlement is also a method of ADR and said, "Section 89 of the Civil Procedure Code also refers to the Judicial Settlement as one of the modes of alternative dispute resolution. In a Judicial Settlement, the concerned Judge tries to settle the dispute between the parties amicably. If, at the instance of judiciary, any amicable settlement is resorted to and arrived at in the given case, then such settlement will be deemed to be decree within the meaning of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987; Section 21 of the Act provides that every award of the Lok Adalat shall be deemed to be a decree of the Civil Court. There are no written guidelines prescribed in India as to judicial settlement. But in America, ethics requiring judicial settlement has been enumerated by Goldschmidt and Milford".

At last the session concluded with the Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr. K.B. Asthana, Dean, School of Law. Dr. Asthana said that Alternate Dispute Resolution method shows the importance of Article 21 of the Constitution of India which stands for right to life that includes right to have a speedy trial.



Workshop on “Gender Sensitization” by Delhi Police

CPJ College successfully organized a Workshop on “Gender Sensitization” in collaboration with Delhi Police on **12-February-2019** in the College Auditorium. The workshop began with the National Anthem followed by the Lighting of Auspicious lamp to worship Maa Sarawati. The main purpose of the workshop was to make the students and faculty members aware about the concept of gender sensitization and to highlight the main provisions of Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and other provisions of the laws relating to protection of rights of women and children.

He also emphasized on the education of women and their economic independence which can play an important role leading to enhance their status and equal opportunities in every sphere of life, has in general, and at home in particular. He also stressed that as students and faculty one has to sensitize the general public to be more flexible and sympathetic towards women's empowerment and spread

awareness collectively to find social and legal remedies and effective solutions to women's problems.

Overall the workshop was interactive and fruitful, as students learnt a lot about the various schemes floated by the Government of India for the welfare of women and children. At last, the session was concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. K.B. Asthana, Dean, School of Law.

He also highlighted the commitment and the best services being provided by the Authority.

The presentation was regarding the concept of PLV and explaining the main Criteria for giving free legal service to poor people, SC/ST and to the category of people defined in Sec. 12 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987. The main purpose of the Act is to provide free legal services to eligible candidates and to organize Lok Adalats for speedy resolution of cases. In the last, the session concluded with the Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr. K. B. Asthana, Dean-School of Law.

A movie screening with the title- "Twelve Angry Men", was organized by School of Law for the 2nd Semester students of B.A.LL.B and BBA LL.B on **14-January-2019**. The movie is based on the courtroom drama. In purpose, it's a crash course in those passages of the Constitution that promise defendants a fair trial and the presumption of innocence. It has a reflection of stark simplicity. Apart from a brief setup and a briefer epilogue, the entire film takes place within a small New York City jury room, as 12 men debate the fate of a young defendant charged with murdering his father.

The story is based on a television play by Reginald Rose, later made into a movie by Sidney Lumet, with Rose and Henry Fonda acting as co-producers and putting up their own money to finance it. The cast included only one bankable star Fonda, but the other 11 actors were among the best then working in New York, including Martin Balsam, Lee J. Cobb, E. G. Marshall, Jack Klugman, Jack Warden, Ed Begley and Robert Webber. They smoke, they sweat, they swear, they sprawl, they stalk, and they get angry.

In a length of only 95 minutes (it sometimes feels as if the movie is shot in real time), the jurors are all defined in terms of their personalities, backgrounds, occupations, prejudices and emotional tilts. Evidence is debated so effectively that the audience could feel that they know as much as the jury does, especially about the old man who says he heard the murder and

saw the defendant fleeing and the lady across the street who says she saw it happen through the windows of a moving train. In this movie, one can see the murder weapon, a switch-blade knife, and hear the jurors debate the angle of the knife wound. One can watch as Fonda imitates the shuffling step of the old man, a stroke victim, to see if he could have gotten to the door in time to see the murderer fleeing. In its ingenuity, in the way it balances one piece of evidence against another that seems contradictory, "12 Angry Men" is as meticulous as the summation of an Agatha Christie thriller.

WHAT IS ARTICLE 370

Article 370 of the Indian Constitution is a 'temporary provision' which grants special autonomous status to Jammu & Kashmir. Under Part XXI of the Constitution of India, which deals with "Temporary, Transitional and Special provisions", the state of Jammu & Kashmir has been accorded special status under Art370. All the provisions of the Constitution which are applicable to other states are not applicable to J&K. For example, till 1965, J&K had a Sadr-e-Riyasat for governor and prime minister in place of chief minister.

According to this article, except for defence, foreign affairs, finance and communications, Parliament needs the state government's concurrence for applying all other laws. Thus, the state's residents live under a separate set of laws, including

those related to citizenship, ownership of property, and fundamental rights, as compared to other Indians. As a result of this provision, Indian citizens from other states cannot purchase land or property in Jammu & Kashmir.

After Kashmir's special status is gone, people from anywhere in India be able to buy property and permanently settle in the state. This has fuelled fear in the mind of Kashmiris – they think it would lead to the state's demographic transformation from majority Muslim to majority Hindu.
